Recommendations for use

Preparation of Spray Mixture

Add the recommended quantity of **Marathon** to 2/3 of the required quantity of water in the tank and stir then fill up to the required mark. Apply as a full cover spray ensuring even and complete coverage of all plant surfaces. For tank mixtures, dilute the required quantity of the product in a bucketful of water and then add it to the bulk of spray.

Compatibility

Marathon is compatible with most commonly used fungicides and insecticides apart from highly alkaline compounds.

Precautions
